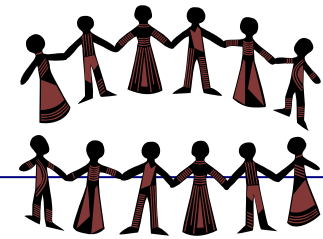

The College Scholars Program (CSP) at Case Western Reserve University is designed for a small group of outstanding undergraduates—approximately 20 are accepted each year—in the arts, humanities, sciences, engineering, nursing, mathematics and natural sciences, and the social sciences who are interested in exploring how academic learning can address global concerns.



The program emphasizes **interdisciplinary and experiential learning** and the moral demands of modern **leadership and communication** both on the Case campus and beyond and promotes **self-discovery and community building** by students.



What does CSP actually do?

In CSP, you learn by doing, take initiative, and broaden your intellectual horizons.

Where else do the students decide what the class studies? In CSP, the guest lecturers come from all over the world, the Cake and Coffee Committee arranges informal chats with professors, and joint classes between scholar-cohorts creates a dynamic community anyone would want to join.



Final projects by CSP students have an impact on the campus, community, and world. In the past, projects have included writing books and col-

lections of poetry, producing art, and studying everything from video game development to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. CSP students have also studied alternative medicine, interviewed immigrants, become certified doulas, organized community music events. The possibilities are limitless.
