Noted film critic Jonathan Rosenbaum will visit Case Western Reserve University Oct. 3 from 12:30 to 1:45 in Clark Hall 309. Rosenbaum served as the film critic for the *Chicago Reader* for more than 20 years and has published more than 10 books on world cinema, including in-depth studies of Orson Welles and of Iranian filmmaker Abbas Kiarostami.
